

## EDGE Awarded AED 1 Billion Contract to Supply AL TARIQ PGMs to the UAE Armed Forces

The new contract will enhance the UAE Armed Forces air strike capabilities through increasing standoff ranges with advanced AL TARIQ-LR PGMs. Additional features from a recent Block II upgrade will also be included.
