

ADDED and EDGE Sign Cooperation Agreement to Enhance Abu Dhabi's Industrial Capabilities



EDGE, one of the world's leading advanced technology and defence groups, and the Abu Dhabi Department of Economic Development (ADDED), the catalyst for economic growth and diversification in the emirate of Abu Dhabi, signed a cooperation agreement today to explore opportunities in strengthening the industrial capabilities of the UAE's largest emirate.
